How-To Read a "Visceptual"

"Visceptuals" are designed for the "Ys-Ways Capable" and their Cohorts/Supporters who can complement and collaborate with those who have the *Right Stuff* in a 4IR "A.I.- Age of Automation" workplace. Those with Ys-Ways will comprise the Top Tier of the U.S. Workforce across all industries (as they do in SciTech today).

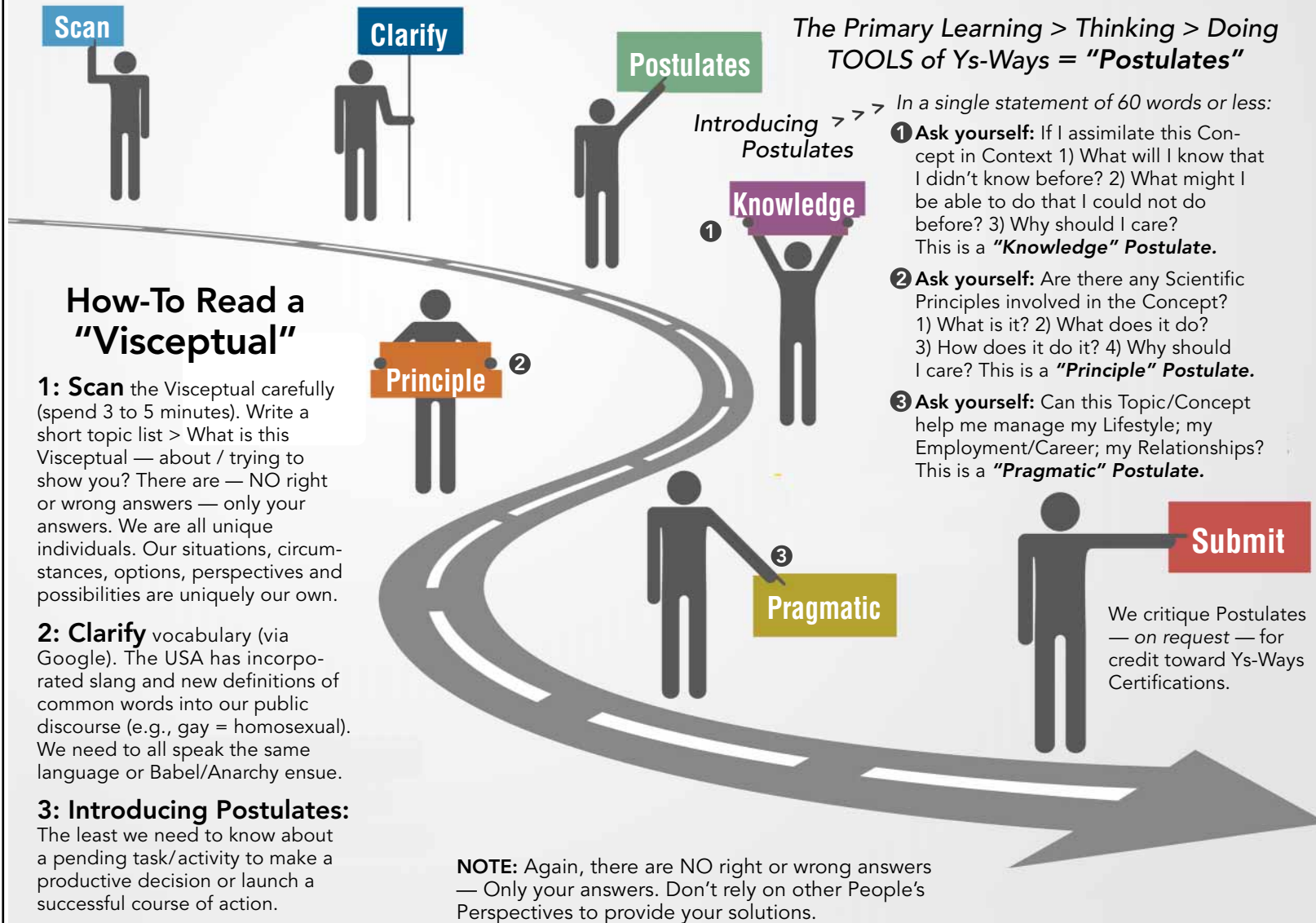
A "Visceptual" — is a multi-faceted, multi-levelled, coherent, Science/Statistical-based "Concept in Context" — whose Content and Components are apparent in a single glance (presented *Visually* for a Ys audience that assimilates — *instead of* — *Verbally* for an X-cetera audience that memorizes).

The difference between "assimilating" and "memorizing" is —

- Assimilating catalogues Relationally in Context according to Consequences: Right Brain activity.
- Memorizing files chronologically / topically / logically (inference) / perhaps alphabetically: Left Brain activity.

A Visceptual is an intellectual communication — NOT an emotional one.

Each of our Bi-weekly "Ys-Ways to" Series contains a Visceptual. A Visceptual + Google can replace a 500-page, \$200 textbook, and semesters' worth of lectures in 4–6 hours. You have never approached learning this way because Ys-Ways "Conceptual/Contextual Thinking" is not allowed in U.S. K-8/12/16 Cognitive Thinking, data-based schooling. U.S. K-8/12/16 maternal schooling is X-cetera driven and leaves out the Ys-er Right Stuff.



How-To Read a "Visceptual"

1: Scan the Visceptual carefully (spend 3 to 5 minutes). Write a short topic list > What is this Visceptual — about / trying to show you? There are — NO right or wrong answers — only your answers. We are all unique individuals. Our situations, circumstances, options, perspectives and possibilities are uniquely our own.

2: Clarify vocabulary (via Google). The USA has incorporated slang and new definitions of common words into our public discourse (e.g., gay = homosexual). We need to all speak the same language or Babel/Anarchy ensue.

3: Introducing Postulates: The least we need to know about a pending task/activity to make a productive decision or launch a successful course of action.
