Sample Postulate

Topic/Concept: The U.S. Constitution

• What is it? The U.S. Constitution is a Contract between

Americans and their government

- What does it do? It organizes American society
- How does it do it? It provides a political/legal structure of the people, managed by the people, operated for the people
- Why should I care? It optimizes the options and opportunities of all citizens while protecting the Rights of Minorities based on the "Rule of Law" = NO Law may violate the U.S. Constitution.
- What can I do to accommodate, adept-adapt? Understand how the U.S. Constitution can affect my options and opportunities and PREP: "By failing to prepare you are preparing to fail." (Ben Franklin)

Combine the above into a coherent statement of 72 Words or less. (It's the least you need to know.)


The U.S. Constitution is a Contract between Americans and their government that organizes American society by providing a political/ legal structure of the people, managed by the people, operated for the people, that optimizes the options and opportunities of all citizens while protecting the Rights of Minorities based on the "Rule of Law" = NO Law may violate the U.S. Constitution.

A **Postulate** is a method for "Prioritizing" options and opportunities in — Life > Employment > Relationships — by formalizing the least you need to know to make a productive decision or launch a successful course of action.

A Postulate answers 5 questions in a single statement of 72 words or less: 1) What is it? 2) What does it do? 3) How does it do it? 4) Why should I care? 5) What can I do to cope, adjust and protect, my position? Question 4 is the most important. You should not waste your time considering another person's interests/issues that do not complement/affect your own.
